What's hiding behind those corporate doors? It just might be a program that doubles your charitable donation! They are called *Matching Gift and Volunteering Programs*.

A little known fact ... 65% of Fortune 500 companies and many other smaller companies both here and abroad regard Matching Gift and Volunteer programs as an important element of their philanthropic culture.

While such programs are structured in accordance with the company's mission, they are similar in design. They work like this: the employee/retiree contributes to a charity or foundation (usually a 50lc3 organization) and the company then matches the gift, often on a dollar-for-dollar basis or according to a specified formula.

In other words, with a matching gift it may be possible to double your contribution. *Matching gifts enable you to direct a portion of the company's monies, already earmarked for charitable contributions, to causes that matter to you.* 

Volunteer your time working for a special group or charitable event? Companies often have alternative or additional programs offering donations based on your volunteer services. Some even go so far as to match your personal fundraising efforts from family, friends and co-workers in conjunction with an event you participate in —say a run or walk or charitable event.



Running a **WAVE** program at your club? Your volunteer hours helping out on this FCAF special project for wounded veterans might well qualify—check it out!

- Check with your current or former employer for their Matching Gift or Volunteer programs. For larger corporations, this information is often online. If not, email the Human Resources Department.
- Follow the instructions carefully for making a matching gift request.
- If your company has these kinds of programs, do let us know. That way, we can provide a list to other FCA members and friends who could also take advantage of this opportunity to support the FCAF as well.
